WAYNE W. SELL EXPANDS FLEET

Twenty-one tractors and ten nomadic tanks purchased throughout 2011

PITTSBURGH, PA – September 12, 2011 – Wayne W. Sell Corporation (Wayne W. Sell), a leader in the transportation of flat, van and bulk commodities across the Midwest and North East, today announced the company's notable 2011 equipment purchases. The company's purchases updated its equipment, reduced the average age of its fleet and increased its fleet size to 70 tractors and 95 bulk tank trailers.

Throughout the year, Wayne W. Sell purchased twenty-one Peterbilt tractors. Eleven of these tractors replaced old equipment and the remaining increased the company's fleet of tractors by 10. In addition, to meet the growing demand of customers working in the Marcellus Shale industry, Wayne W. Sell purchased 10 new Heil dry bulk tank trailers.

President John Sell explains, "We are very happy about the new equipment and plan to continue this trend of expanding and updating our fleet. This year's purchases were significant and helped us get the fleet back on track after a few years of not adding new trucks. In the next five to seven years, our fleet will be on a regular five year cycle with new trucks purchased each year, replacing existing trucks that are five years old." Additionally he states, "We plan to grow the fleet by five to seven trucks per year."
